The Department of Physics at Miami University seeks to fill a tenure-track appointment in experimental biophysics at the Assistant Professor level to begin in August 2012. Candidates must hold the Ph.D. by time of appointment in physics, biophysics, or related discipline. Preference will be given to candidates whose research complements biophysics and biological physics research ongoing in the Department. Candidates with research that is interdisciplinary in nature are welcome, as there are also efforts in bioengineering, and structural and cellular biophysics throughout the University. Research that is applied or biomedical in nature are also welcome. Responsibilities will include teaching at the undergraduate and master's levels, establishing a productive, externally funded research program, and contributing to professional service. Applicants should demonstrate a strong interest in undergraduate and graduate education, including both classroom teaching and student research mentoring. The successful candidate is expected to contribute to the Department's new undergraduate degree program in biological physics.
